> ORDINANCE NUMBER 46 :
> The village council of the villoge of Pine River, do ordain as follows:

> Section 1, The village limits of the village of Pine River shall be extended so as to include the fol lowing described land, adjoining aid village, tom wit:

> Commencing at the intersection of the southerly line of Mill Street with the west line of Arline Street in the Village of Pine River, runming thence in a southwesterly direction following the west line of Arline Street in said Village, a distrance of 260 feet, more or less, to the point where said west line of Arlina Street intersects the west one-sixteenth line running through section 6, Township 137, Range 29, thence south on said one-sixteenth line a distance of about 100 feet to the center of the Northwest Quaiter of Section 6, thence west on the north one-sixteenth line through Section 6, to the point on said onesixteenth line where the same would intersect a line extended through the center of Norway Avenue in said Village, running thence northeasterly on said center line of Norway Avenue extended, to the point whens the center line of Norway Avenue extended would intersect with the southerly line of Mill Street in said Village of Pine River, thence southeasterly on said line of Mill Street" to point of beginning, containing 4.3 acres more or less, said property abutting upon the limits of the incorporated village of Pine -River be, and the same is hereby annexed to such villoge, and shall hereby become a part of such village as effectively. as if it had been originally a part thereof.
