A PROCLAMATION OF THE
GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, CONCERNING THE DRESS

WHEREAS, there has been an increased attention on the part of the general public throughout the nation that proper dress is fundamental to our business and social progress; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the textile and apparel industries play an extremely important part in the economy and well-being of our country, giving employment to large numbers of people; and

WHEREAS, dress which is in good taste, attractive and well kept goes a long way toward improving morale, promoting healthy social relations and good citizenship;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, do hereby proclaim the week of March 1st through March 6th, 1959 as

NATIONAL "DRESS WEEK" WEEK FOR MEN, YOUNG MEN AND BOYS

and urge all citizens to pay particular attention to their dress for this week and to be governed by the dress requirements demanded by the occasion.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-second day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine and of the state, the one hundred first.
