CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTORS OF ELECTION.

We Charles McGullough, Andrew Hagenson, and Max Sebestor
being duly sworn, and being the three persons appointed by the
Village Council of the Village of McKinley, St. Louis County,
Minnesota, as inspectors to act as Judges of the election held

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Charles McCullough, Andrew Hagenson and Max Skuster are hereby appointed inspectors, who shall act as judges of said election and conduct the same so far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers, and that only voters residing within said territory shall be entitled to vote at said election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That due notice of said election shall be given by the Village Clerk according to law, and posted in not less than three public places within said territory.
