

A PROCLAMATION FOR "BROTHERHOOD WEEK"

WHEREAS, the annual celebration of Brotherhood Week, to be held February 15 through 22, 1959, is sponsored by the National Conference of Christians and Jews; and

WHEREAS, the National Conference of Christians and Jews is diligently working to establish a social order in which the religious ideals of brotherhood and justice shall become the standards of human relationships; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of Brotherhood Week is to symbolize renewed dedication to the ideals of greater tolerance, understanding, friendship and cooperation among all our citizens, and greater respect for the differences and beliefs of our people; and

WHEREAS, our strength as one nation under God depends on our unity and informed vigilance as a free people; and

WHEREAS, Brotherhood Week is in the tradition established by our forefathers and enunciated in the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution and deserves the wholehearted cooperation of all the people of our State;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 15 through February 22, 1959 as

"BROTHERHOOD WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge the people of this state to observe this week with full awareness of their responsibility to increase that spirit of brotherhood so essential to the progress of our state and our nation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-eighth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine and of the state the one hundred first.

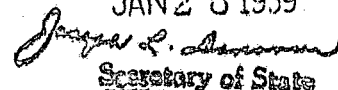
