**LEGAL NOTICES**

**ORDINANCE 13**  
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING  
THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF  
THE VILLAGE OF WOLF  
LAKE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN  
PLATTED AND UNPLATTED  
LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200  
ACRES IN AREA.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated December 18, 1958, requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the council on the 13 day of January 1959.

The Council of the Village of Wolf Lake ordains:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows: "Beginning at the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest quarter (sw 1/4 sw 1/4) of Section Thirty-four (34), Township One Hundred Thirty-nine (139) North, Range Thirty-seven (37) West of the Fifth (5th) Principal Meridian in Becker County, Minnesota, and running in a Northernly direction one thousand eighty-nine (1089) feet; thence running four hundred twenty-two (422) feet in the Easterly direction; thence running Southerly one thousand eighty-nine (1089) feet; thence running Westerly four hundred twenty-two (422) feet to the point of beginning and there terminating."

The herein described tract is subject to an easment for Public Road purposes along its Westerly and Southerly boundaries.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the secretary of state and in the office of the county auditor of Becker County.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this ordinance have been filed as directed in section 2.

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby declared that the territory described below shall be subject to village government.

Section 2. Territory annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:  
Beginning at the southwest corner of the southwest quarter (1/4 1/4 SW 1/4) of section thirty-four (34), Township one hundred thirty-nine (139) North, Range thirty-seven (37) East of the fifth (5th) principal meridian in

twenty-two (22) feet in the westerly direction; thence running southerly one thousand eighty-nine (189) feet; thence running westerly four hundred twenty-two (422) feet to the point of beginning and thence terminating.

The herein described tract is subject to an easement for public road purposes along its westerly and southerly boundaries.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the secretary of state and in the office of the county auditor of Becker County.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this ordinance have been filed as directed in section 3.
