RESOLUTION

IN THE MATTER OF ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF
DETROIT LAKES.

WHEREAS a verified petition addressed to the City Council of the City of Detroit Lakes, pursuant to M.S.A., Section 413.12 as amended, has been filed, signed by more than five (5) legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, petitioning the City Council to call an election for the determination of a proposed annexation of the following described territory to the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast Corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 27, Township 139 North, Range 41, West of the 5th P.M., thence West 1320 feet along the northern section line of said section to the Northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section, Township and Range aforesaid; thence South 1320 feet on a line parallel with the eastern boundary line of said section to the Southwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section; thence East along the southern boundary line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 1320 feet, more or less, to the eastern boundary line of said section; thence north along the eastern boundary line of said section to the point of beginning, comprising 40 acres more or less, according to Government survey,

and further contained within the above described boundary lines are the following plats which have been approved by the County Board of Commissioners of Becker County and recorded with the Register of Deeds of said County:

Haas and Hanson Subdivision
Haas and Hanson First Addition
Haas and Hanson Second Addition
and other lands

AND WHEREAS, a census has been taken of the resident population of the above described territory which census discloses that there are more than 75 persons resident therein; that the said territory adjoins the present limits of the City of Detroit Lakes and that no part thereof is more than one and one-half miles from the present city limits of the City of Detroit Lakes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Detroit Lakes as follows:

1. That the Petition for Annexation above referred to be received.
2. That an election determining said proposed annexation will be held on Friday, January 23, 1959.
3. That the place of such election shall be the home of William Henderson located at Lot 8, Haas and Hanson 1st Addition, Dean Avenue, Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, and that the said polling place shall be open on said date between the hours of 10 a.m., and 8 p.m.
4. That copies of the Petition for Annexation, together with a notice attached thereto fixing the time and place for holding the election, shall be forthwith posted in three public places within said territory.
5. That the following persons, residents of the territory described above, shall be and hereby are appointed inspectors of said election:

Ardelle Nustad, Eileen Henderson, Alice Engstrom

who shall act as judges of the election and conduct the same so far as practical in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers. Only voters residing within the territory shall be entitled to vote.

6. That the ballots shall bear the words "For annexation, Yes _____; No _____", with a space after each of the last two words, one of which the voters shall make a cross to indicate his choice.
7. That immediately after said election, the inspectors shall canvass the ballots and forthwith make and file with the Clerk of the City of Detroit Lakes a certificate stating the time and place of holding the election; that they have canvassed the ballots cast thereat and the numbers cast for and against the proposition. The certificate shall be signed and verified by all of the inspectors to the effect that the statements therein are true.
8. That the City Clerk of the City of Detroit Lakes shall attach the certificate of the inspectors to the original petition; that a copy of the Resolution appointing the inspectors and the original proofs of posting of the election notices shall be attached thereto, and file the whole as one document in his office. If the certificate shows that the majority of votes cast were in the affirmative, he shall forthwith make and transmit to the Secretary of State a certified copy of the document to be filed as a public record and transmit to the Auditor of the County in which the city is situated a certified copy of the document to be filed as a public record.





PETITION FOR ANNEXATION
OF CERTAIN LANDS IN BECKER COUNTY, MINNESOTA

TO THE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF DETROIT LAKES,
MINNESOTA:

We, the undersigned, legal voters residing in the territory hereinafter described, respectfully request that you call an election to determine the annexation of the territory hereinafter described, to the City of Detroit Lakes, all pursuant to U.S.A., Section 413.12.

Your petitioners state:

1. That the territory contains a population not less than 75 persons; that it is not included in any incorporated city; that it adjoins the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota; and that no part of the territory hereinafter described is more than one and one-half miles from the present city limits of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, which it now adjoins.

2. That the territory proposed to be annexed to the City of Detroit Lakes is located in the County of Becker, State of Minnesota, and with boundaries described as follows:
