A PROCLAMATION FOR "CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH WEEK"

WHEREAS, health, appearance and personal well-being of children and adults are greatly influenced by the condition of the teeth and mouth; and

WHEREAS, early preventive measures can protect our children from a large part of the dental diseases, especially tooth decay, that affect more than 95 percent of our people; and

WHEREAS, 1959 is the Centennial Year of the American Dental Association;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 9 through February 14, 1959 as

"CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH WEEK"

and urge that all citizens and all community organizations join in the observance.
