A PROCLAMATION FOR "MINNESOTA BEAUTY SALON WEEK"

WHEREAS, The National Hairdressers and Cosmetologists Association has set the week of February 3 through February 14, 1959 as National Beauty Salon Week, a week dedicated to more beautiful women; and

WHEREAS, this association which is devoted to improving the standards of professional beauty care, seeks to help all women to greater beauty; and

WHEREAS, the members of this association annually conduct an intensive program to provide professional beauty care to people confined to homes for the aged and orphaned, hospitals and other similar institutions; and

WHEREAS, this program has contributed immeasurably to the physical and mental well-being of over a million patients in such institutions in recent years and has received praise and recognition from the medical profession for its great therapeutic value; and

WHEREAS, this profession offers unlimited opportunities for creative careers to the youth of America;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 3 through February 14, 1959, as

"MINNESOTA BEAUTY SALON WEEK"

and urge all Minnesota citizens to give due recognition to the hairdressers and cosmetologists of Minnesota whose services are dedicated to the service of the women of our state.
