TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF THE COUNTY OF ST. LOUIS,
IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

The undersigned, your petitioners, respectfully represent:

1. That they, and each of them, are legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described sought to be incorporated as a village, as hereinafter designated in the column marked "Place of residence", opposite the signatures of said Petitioners.

2. That said territory, hereinafter described, sought to be incorporated, is not in any incorporated village or city and is in the State of Minnesota; that the following described territory, a part of said territory sought to be incorporated, has been platted into lots and blocks as the Plat of Franklin, which said plat has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this State and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds for the County of St. Louis, to-wit:

The Westerly 518 feet of said Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nine (9) in said Township fifty-eight (58) North, of Range Seventeen (17) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, more fully described as follows: Commencing at the sixteenth post East of the West quarter post of Section Nine (9), thence North 89 degrees 30 minutes East 518 feet along the centre line of said Section, thence North 0 degrees 2 minutes East 1403.9 feet to the North sub-division line of said Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$), thence North 89 degrees 13 minutes West 518 feet to the sixteenth post, thence South 0 degrees 2 minutes West 1415.5 feet to the point of beginning.

The South one-half of Northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Four (4), the South one-half of Northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Five (5), the East one-half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Eight (8), the West one-half of Northeast quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$), the West one-half of Southeast quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$), the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the West one-half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Nine (9), all in Township Fifty-eight (58) North of Range Seventeen (17) West in St. Louis County, Minnesota, except that part of the West one-half of Southeast quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Eight (8), going described as follows: Commencing at the centre of said Section Eight (8), going thence east along the east and west quarter line two hundred (200) feet, thence south one hundred and eighty (180) feet, thence west two hundred (200) feet to the north and south quarter line, thence north one hundred and eighty (180) feet to the place of beginning; the territory to be incorporated as a village embracing 1320 acres of land, more or less, according to the Government Survey.
