ORDINANCE NO. 164

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS
AND INCORPORATE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY THEREIN

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS DOES ORDAIN:


Section 15:04. Village Boundaries Extended. Pursuant to a petition
duly signed by all of the owners of the land described as follows:

That part of the South one-half of the Southwest one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter ($S\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Thirty-six (36) North, Range Thirty-one (31) West, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the East line of a Township Road as now constructed and traveled Thirty-three (33) feet due East of the Northwest corner of said South one-half of the Southwest one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter ($S\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Fourteen (14), Township 36, Range 31; thence due East along the North line of said South one-half of the Southwest one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter ($S\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$) for One Hundred Seventy (170) feet; thence due South and parallel with the West line of said South one-half of the Southwest one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter ($S\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{4} SW\frac{1}{4}$) Three Hundred Forty-nine and seven-tenths (349.7) feet to the Northeast corner of Larson's Second Addition; thence West along the North line of said Larson's Second Addition One Hundred Seventy (170) feet to an intersection with the said East line of said Township Road; thence North along said East line of said Township Road for Three Hundred Fifty and five-tenths (350.5) feet to the point of beginning and there terminating, said tract containing One and thirty-seven hundredths (1.37) acres, more or less, and platted as Larson's Third Addition. The territorial limits of the village are hereby extended to include such land within its limits, which shall hereafter be governed as other territory of the village is governed.

Section 15:08. Copies to be Filed. The Village Clerk shall forward a certificate of this ordinance to the Secretary of State and to the County Auditor for Benton County, Minnesota.


Section 15:09. Effect. Such land shall be annexed upon the filing of the certified copies hereof with the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.
