

ORDINANCE NO. 85

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE VILLAGE OF POLLEY AND

WHEREAS, the Xerde Reservation herein constituted a town road of the Town of Gilmanton and the Town Board of said Town of Gilmanton passed a resolution on the 20th day of May, 1958, relinquishing and giving up jurisdiction over said lands on a town road in favor of the Village of Polley, so that the same could be incorporated into the limits of said Village and become a public street therein; and

WHEREAS, said resolution was passed by said Town Board at the request of said Village of Polley and upon the agreement by the Village of Polley to accept the same and incorporate it as a village street in said Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POLLEY,
HEREAFTER, BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. That the village boundaries of the Village of Polley are hereby extended so as to include the following described lands abutting upon said village, to-wit:

A tract of land four rods in width in Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), extending from the center of said Section due south about 1,725 foot to the center line of State Trunk Highway No. 33, the center line of said tract being the west line of the Southeast Quarter (SE^{1/4}) of said Section, and said tract being formerly a part of a town road of the Town of Gilmanton, Benton County, Minnesota.

Section 2. That said tract of land is hereby declared to be a public street of the Village of Polley, known as Extension to Second Avenue.

Adopted at a Regular Meeting of the Village Council held on the 10th day of February, 1959.
