A PROCLAMATION FOR "CHILD EVANGELISM WEEK"

WHEREAS, the International Child Evangelism Fellowship is an interdenominational, non-sectarian organization, seeking to reach the unchurched children of our Nation through the establishment of home Bible classes in every state; and

WHEREAS, the delinquency problem of the country has been definitely linked with the lack of Bible teaching; and

WHEREAS, we feel that the program of Child Evangelism Fellowship will go a long way toward reducing the delinquency problem;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of February 22 through March 1, 1959 as

"CHILD EVANGELISM WEEK"

in Minnesota and urge the people of this state to participate in every phase of Child Evangelism Week.
