WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of each Minnesotan to use these facilities so that his neighbor and our visitors from all over the world may continue to enjoy them; and




NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the year 1959 as
