NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate March 13, 1959 as

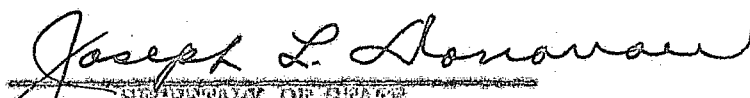
"PAUL JONES DAY"
