



ELECTION AND DESIGNATING ELECTION JUDGES.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated January 20, 1959, requesting that an election be held on the question of incorporating certain territory described therein as the Village of Landfall, Minnesota, was duly presented to this board on the 3rd day of February, 1959; and

WHEREAS, said petition is in proper form and it appears therefrom that the same was signed by the requisite number of qualified persons and that the territory described therein contains a resident population of 313 persons,
