

Ordinance No. 105

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE
OF MILACA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated 24 March, 1959, requesting
annexation of the territory described below was duly presented
to the council on the 25th day of March, 1959.

The Council of the Village of Milaca ordains:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the
territory described below abuts upon the village, is so conditioned
as properly to be subjected to village government, and that the
proposed annexation is in the best interest of the village and of
said territory involved.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the
village are hereby extended to include the territory described as
follows:

Commencing at the intersection point of the East boundary
line and the South boundary line of the West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$)
of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$), Section 24, Township 38,
Range 27, thence proceeding a distance of 600.0 feet
North on and along the said East boundary line of said
West Half of Southwest Quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{4}$), Section 24;
thence proceeding due West to a point which lies 150.0
feet due West of the West boundary line of the Minn.
Department of Highway's easement as now of record for
that trunk highway known as Minn. Trunk Highway No. 169;
thence proceeding in a Southerly direction parallel to
said East boundary line of said West Half of Southwest
Quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{4}$), Section 24, a distance of 600.0 feet
to the South line of said Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$);
thence proceeding East on and along the said South bound-
ary line of said Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) to the said
place of beginning, all of said tract being situated
within the West Half of the Southwest Quarter ($W\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{4}$)
of Section 24, Township 38, Range 27, Mille Lacs County.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file
certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the secretary of
state and in the office of the county auditor of Mille Lacs County.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall
be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this
ordinance have been filed as directed in section 3.

ORDINANCE NO. 105
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE
CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VIL-
LAGE OF MILACA TO INCLUDE
CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT
EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated
March 24, 1959, requesting annexation
of the territory described below was
duly presented to the Council on the
25th day of March, 1959.

The Council of the Village of Milaca
ordains:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby
determined that the territory described
below abuts upon the Village, is so
conditioned as properly to be sub-
jected to Village Government, and that
the proposed annexation is in the best
interest of the Village and of said
territory involved.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The
corporate limits of the Village are
hereby extended to include the terri-
tory described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection
point of the East boundary line and
the South boundary line of the
West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest
Quarter (S $\frac{1}{4}$). Section 24, Town-
ship 38, Range 27, thence proceed-
ing a distance of 600.0 feet North
on and along the said East bound-
ary line of said West Half of
Southwest Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Section 24; thence proceeding due
west to a point which lies 150.0
feet due West of the West bound-
ary line of the Minn. Department
of Highway's easement as now of
record for that trunk Highway
known as Minn. Trunk Highway
No. 169; thence proceeding in a
Southerly direction parallel to said
East boundary line of said West
Half of Southwest Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$
SW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 24, a distance of
600.0 feet to the South line of said
Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$); thence
proceeding East on and along
the said South boundary line of
said Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) to
the said place of beginning, all
of said tract being situated within
the West Half of the Southwest
Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24,
Township 38, Range 27, Mille Lacs
County.

fice Secretary of State and in the
office of the County Auditor of
Mille Lacs County.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexa-
tion. Annexation shall be completed
from and after the date when certified
copies of this ordinance have been filed
as directed in section 2.

being duly sworn, on oath says:

that She is, and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher or printer of the
newspaper known as the Mille Lacs County Times and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter
stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the Notice hereinafter
described, said newspaper was printed and published in the Village of Milaca, in the county of
Mille Lacs, State of Minnesota, on Thursday of each week; that during all said time said
newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within
the village of Milaca from which it purports to be issued as above stated and in newspaper
format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single
column, two inches wide; has been issued once each week from a known office established in
said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and equipped with the necessary
material for preparing and printing the same, and the presswork on that part of the newspaper
devoted to local news of interest to the community which it purports to serve has been done in
its known office of publication; that during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five
per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community
it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication,
and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been
circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and
forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter
in its local post office; has filed a copy of each issue with the State Historical Society, St. Paul;
and that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Mille Lacs County, Minne-
sota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of
said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal
newspaper.

That the Notice hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was
printed and published therein in the English language, once each week for one
