AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE SALE AND PURCHASE OF AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE

WHEREAS, in spite of the average careful citizens' efforts, the number who die and those many who are injured through accidents and diseases each year has steadily increased; and

WHEREAS, there are hazards in the home and on the highway that lie beyond the conscious control of the individual, even beyond his human intent and awareness of moral responsibility and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that we set aside a period of time to focus public attention on the necessity of protection against accidents and diseases, emphasizing the importance of a reverence for life, one's own as well as the lives of others;

IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 19 through April 23, 1959 as

"ACCIDENT AND DISEASE PREVENTION WEEK"

to Minnesota in recognition of the insurance industry and the vital contributions to the protection of human life, health and property.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol on twenty-third day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine and of the State one hundred thirty.
