A PROCLAMATION FOR "SAFETY DAY IN DULUTH"

WHEREAS, safety on streets and highways becomes more important as our population grows; and

WHEREAS, traffic safety should be the paramount concern of every motorist every time he or she is driving an automobile; and

WHEREAS, a safe car free of mechanical defects is as important as the safe driving habits of every motorist.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the day of April 14, 1959 as

"SAFETY DAY IN DULUTH"

and urge every motorist to drive a safe car and to bring his or her car into their dealer for free safety checks.
