ORDINANCE NO. 204.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LOTS 1 TO 4 INCLUSIVE OF VERTIN'S  
OUT-LOTS TO THE CITY OF LITTLE FALLS.

The Common Council of the City of Little Falls do ordain that,

WHEREAS the owners of more than one-half of the platted territory hereinafter described have petitioned the said Common Council of the City of Little Falls, Minnesota, to annex said territory to said City of Little Falls and have complied with all the provisions and requirements of the Charter of said city of Little Falls relating to the annexation and addition of territory to said city:

Section 1. The territory abutting upon the City of Little Falls hereinafter described is hereby annexed to said City of Little Falls and declared to be an addition to the City of Little Falls, Minnesota, and a part of said city and within the jurisdiction thereof, and is hereby annexed to the Third Ward of said City of Little Falls: Lots numbered 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Vertin's Outlots to Little Falls, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Morrison County, Minnesota.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.


