ORDINATE NO．$/ 75$<br>AN ORDINANCE DETACHING CERTAIN REAL ESTATE TRON THE VILLAGE OF MORGAN

WHERAS，a petition signed by Roy I，Fixsen and others has been filed with the VIllage Clerk requesting that the real estate＊ hereinafter described be detached from the Village of Morgan and

WHEREAS，This council has found and determined and hereby dem clares that such detachment would not unreasonably affect the syminetry of the settled portions of the VIllage，would not unreason－ ably affect the exercise of the powers and functions of the Village， would not reduce the number of inhabitants of the Village below the minimum number required by law for the incorporation of a Village and would be for the best interests of the territory affected．

NOW，THEREFORE THEE VISAGE OF MORGAN DOES ORDAIN：

## Section I．

That the following described real estate lying and being in the Village of Morgan，Redwood County，Minnesota，to wit：

All that part of the West Half of the Southeast Quarter （WI SE者）Dying South of the Chatege and Northwestern Railway right－of way，but excepting therefrom that part thereof used for a cemetery，al 1 in Section Sixteen（16）．Township One Hundred Eleven（111）North，Range Thirty－four West（34）， be and is hereby detached from the Village of Morgan．

## Section II：

That the above described detached tract shall be and remain subject to taxation for the payment of interest and principal on all Village bonded indebtedness outstanding as of the effective date of this ordnance in accordance with Minnesota Statutes Annotated， Section 412.051 ．
