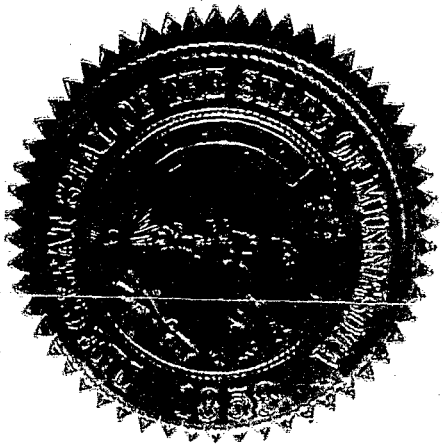

EXECUTIVE ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of
Minnesota, do hereby summon the Legislature and the members
thereof to convene in extra session on Saturday, the twenty-
fifth day of April, 1959, at eleven o'clock in the forenoon of
that day, at the Capitol in Saint Paul, Minnesota.

can I am confident, be made in a few days without additional
cost to the tax payer if the legislature stays on the job.
