A PROCLAMATION FOR "SENIOR CITIZENS MONTH"

WHEREAS, Minnesota now has more than ten percent of her total population in this age group and medical science is continuously lengthening our life span; and

WHEREAS, the prosperity and well-being of our state rests upon the full utilization of experience and skills of all its citizens; and

WHEREAS, an immediate need exists for all our citizens to more fully prepare themselves for a meaningful and independent life by planning for the later years; and

WHEREAS, considerable knowledge has resulted from experience and research in the aging process which knowledge our society has not yet absorbed for its ultimate social and economic benefit.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May as

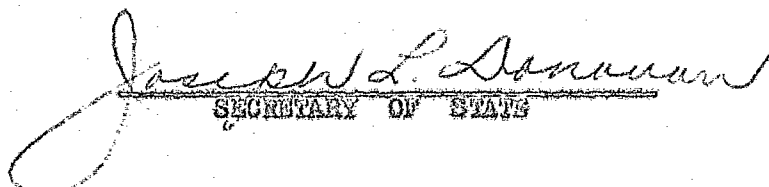
SENIOR CITIZENS MONTH
