WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota is proud to be numbered among the important wool producing and wool manufacturing states; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of September, 1950 as

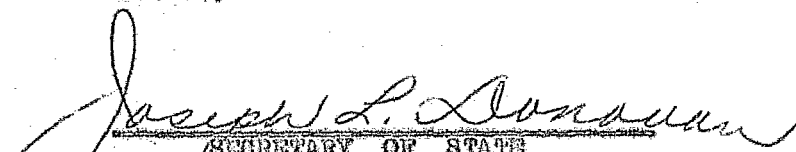
"AMERICAN WOOL MONTH"

in the state of Minnesota, and I urge all citizens of this state to participate in the Salute to American Wool.

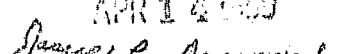
