

A PROCLAMATION FOR "MINNESOTA SAFE BOATING WEEK"

WHEREAS, Minnesota welcomes the boating season with a pride in its marine facilities which have stimulated a tremendous increase in the number of boating enthusiasts locally; and

WHEREAS, the increasing number of boats on our lakes emphasize also the need for safe boating practices which permit maximum enjoyment for all persons; and

WHEREAS, the Coast Guard Auxiliary begins its seventeenth summer of providing free examinations of small boats and public instruction classes to educate newcomers to the boating field so that they might enjoy the pleasures of boating and not regret the tragedies of inexperience;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 27th through July 5, 1959 as


"MINNESOTA SAFE BOATING WEEK"


