A PROCLAMATION FOR "FATHER'S DAY"

WHEREAS, we are honoring our fathers this evening Father's Day,
Sunday, June 21st; and

WHEREAS, the theme for this American Holiday is "JUVENILE INTEREST
STARTS IN THE HOME"; and

WHEREAS, it is the fathers of our land who primarily have built
this great democracy through their teachings and sturdy
devotion to liberty and love of freedom; and

WHEREAS, we look to the father in the home as the molder of
tomorrow's citizens, the builder of good family life and
the foundation of our future and teacher of our young in
the importance of good ethics, fair play, peace and
brotherhood throughout the world;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of
Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 21st, 1959 as

"FATHER'S DAY"

and I call upon all the citizens of this state to observe it in
veneration and displaying the American Flag and otherwise commemo-
rating the Father in the home so that every day in the year may have
the blessings that flow from good fatherhood, good citizenship,
and a strong family life.
