WHEREAS, The "PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF PINE SPRINGS" dated April 21, 1959, was based upon a census taken by Edward Zaspel, Winston E. Sandeen, and Marvis Scheel between the dates of April 20, 1959, and April 21, 1959, and,

WHEREAS, Through a clerical error, the said census did not set forth a correct figure for the total population of the territory described in the foregoing petition and,

WHEREAS, Based upon the census as originally prepared and filed, the undersigned prepared and signed their petition above mentioned, stating the resident population of the area to be 718 persons.

NOW THEREFORE, The undersigned, for the purposes of remedying a clerical error in the preparation of the "Petition for Incorporation of

PINE SPRINGS", dated April 21, 1959, and conforming the said petition to the facts, do hereby amend paragraph 6 of the said petition to read as follows:

"6. The foregoing lands, both platted and unplatte, and bounded as described, contain a resident population of 123 persons, as ascertained by a census which was commenced on the April 20, 1959, and completed on the April 21, 1959, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof."

With the Committee as it appears to the reporter
concerning parcels of land which have been subject to tax and
blotter, which plots have been sold and kept, and are certified
according to the laws of this State and valid for the action of
the Legislature or Board of Tax Commissioners, State of




