
Dear Mr. Donovan:

I am returning herewith the two certified copies of Ordinances No. 126 and 127 of the Village of Mahtomedi annexing certain land to said Village. The annexation of the lands described in said ordinances was done pursuant to Chapter 626, laws 1959 under subdivision 7 of section 3 of said law, which provides that any land entirely surrounded by village land (which is the case in ordinance No. 127) and unplatted or platted land less than 200 acres in which the petition is signed by all of the owners (which is the case in ordinance No. 126) then the Village Council may annex such land without going through the Municipal Commission on Annexation. Those jurisdictional facts are recited in each of the ordinances.

This subdivision further provides as follows:


"Any annexation provided for in this subdivision shall be deemed final upon filing a copy of the ordinance with the commission, the county auditor, and the secretary of state."

to Ordinance annexing certain blocks of  
land (vacated) to Village of Mahtomedi.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MAHTOMEDI DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That pursuant to that certain petition signed by all the owners of the land hereinafter more particularly described in Washington County, Minnesota, containing less than two hundred acres, situated upon land of the Village of Mahtomedi, requesting the annexation of said land to said Village, said petition having been duly filed with the Clerk of said Village; and it appearing that such annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected, the village boundaries of the Village of Mahtomedi are hereby extended to include the following described land, in Washington County, Minnesota, to-wit:

Commencing at a point in the center line of Hickory Street (formerly known as Prospect Street) in the Village of Mahtomedi, where the same is intersected by the westerly line of the former right-of-way of the Minneapolis and St. Paul Suburban Railroad Company, thence westerly along the corner line of said Hickory Street also known as Prospect Street to the center line of Garner Avenue also known as Fairmount Avenue; thence North along the center line of said Garner Avenue to the center line of Woodland Street also known as Iris Street; thence West along the center line of said Woodland Street to the westerly line of said former right-of-way of said suburban railroad company; thence Southerly along said westerly right-of-way line to the point of beginning.

and that said territory is hereby made a part of the Village of Mahtomedi as effectually as if the same had originally been a part of said village.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon the filing of a certified copy thereof with the County Auditor of Washington County, the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota and with the State Municipal Commission on annexation and consolidation, and from and after its publication.
