PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, John Ejerppi of Carlton County in this state was in the month of September, 1914, murdered in said county; and

WHEREAS, the murderer of the said John Ejerppi has not been apprehended and the public welfare requires his capture, conviction, and punishment for said offense;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Winfield S. Hammond, Governor of the State of Minnesota will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator of the said crime or for such information as will lead to his arrest and conviction.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State to be hereto affixed at the Capital in the City of St. Paul, this 25th day of March, 1915.
