
## STATE OF MINNESOTA. EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT.

## PROGLAMATION.

Hammond, Governor of the State of Minnesota will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator of the said crime or for such information as will lead to his arrest and conviction.
