

RESOLVED

At a Regular Meeting, the Corporation of the City of Zimmerman, Minnesota, Incorporated, at regular intervals throughout the year, was held on the 20th day of July, 1950.

Whereas, a certain resolution dated July 10, 1950, concerning annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the Council on the 10th day of July, 1950; and

Whereas, the resolution so passed by all of the members of the Board of Commissioners of the Council of the Village of St. Zenobius having sufficient

Section 1. Resolution. It is hereby determined that the territory described below exists upon the Village and be so constituted as property to be subjected to village government.

Section 2. Boundary Annexed. The following is the boundary of St. Zenobius as hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:


The South Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 32, Township 117, Range 24, except railroad right of way, and except that part described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of the South Half of the Northwest quarter of Section 32, Township 117, Range 24; thence South 77 feet; thence West 161 feet; thence North 77 feet; thence East 161 feet to the place of beginning and excepting that part described as follows: Commencing at a point on the South side of the Great Northern Railroad right of way 123.04 feet Southwesterly of the Northwest corner of Lot 4, Block 2, in Negrole & Cottmann's Addition to St. Zenobius; thence West 103 feet to a point; thence South 150.5 feet to a point; thence West 200.9 feet to a point on railroad right of way; thence Northwesterly along said right of way 196.4 feet to the place of beginning; and except that part described as follows: Commencing at the South side of Great Northern Railroad right of way 319.7 feet Southwesterly of the Northwest corner of Lot 4, Block 2, in Negrole & Cottmann's Addition to St. Zenobius; thence due West 200.9 feet; thence due South 100 feet; thence West 24.5 feet to a point on the South side of Great Northern Railroad right of way; thence Northwesterly 127 7/12 feet along said right of way to the place of beginning, and further excepting the following: First part of the South Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 32, Township 117, Range 24 described as follows: Commencing at a point on the Southwesterly line of State Highway Number 7, 133 feet West of the center line of County Highway Number 140 as now laid out and constructed; thence Eastward along the Southwesterly line of State Highway Number 7 a distance of 210 feet; thence Southerly along a line parallel with the West line of County Highway Number 140 a distance of 160 feet; thence Northwesterly to the West line of County Highway Number 140 along a line parallel with the South line of State Highway Number 7; thence Northwesterly along the West line of County Highway Number 140 a distance of 69 feet to a point 175 feet South of the center line of State Highway Number 7; thence Northwesterly to the point of beginning; and further excepting the following described tract: Commencing at a point on the West side of Section 32, Township 117, Range 24, and the South right of way line of State Highway Number 7; thence Northward along said right of way line a distance of 310 feet to the actual point of beginning; thence Southerly and parallel with said West line of Section 32, Township 117, Range 24, a distance of 250 feet; thence Eastward and parallel with the South right of way line of State Highway Number 7 a distance of 516.1 feet to a point on the Northwesterly right of way line of Hutchinson Branch of Great Northern Railroad; thence Northwesterly along said railroad right of way line a distance of 314.05 feet; thence Northward along said highway right of way line a distance of 734.25 feet to the point of beginning, all of said land being in Hennepin County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the Municipalities Commission, in the office of the Secretary of State and in the office of the County Auditor of Hennepin County.


Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3.

Adopted by the Village Council of St. Bonifacius, Hennepin County, Minnesota on this 10th day of July, 1959.


