Re: Village of Ormsby - Ordinance Annexing Real Property

Under date of June 19, 1959 you wrote me with reference to the above matter as follows:

"We are returning the certified copy of Ordinance Annexing Real Property to the Village of Ormsby, Minnesota.

There is a new annexation code, Chapter 686, Laws 1959, effective April 25, 1959. It is suggested, therefore, reference be made thereto to determine the applicability of said proceedings thereunder."

I have checked the proceedings taken by the Village Council of Ormsby and find that on April 23, 1959 a petition by all of the property owners in the section of property to be annexed to the Village was filed in the office of the Village Clerk.

The Village Council at its meeting held on April 23, 1959 accepted the petition and set a time and place for hearing thereon. After posting notice for the hearing, the Village Council on Nay 25, 1959 adopted an ordinance annexing real property to the Village of Ormsby.

A certified copy of the ordinance was thereafter filed in the office of the County Auditor of Watonwan County, and also in the office of the County Auditor of Martin County. A certified copy of the ordinance was likewise mailed to your office for filing.

The proceedings taken in this matter was commenced prior to the enactment of Chapter 686 of the Laws of 1959 so I am assumming that it was in order for the Village of Ormsby to complete the annexation proceedings under the old statute.

Examining Section 686 of the Laws of 1959, particularly Subdivision 7, it appears to me that so far as this annexation proceedings is concerned Subdivision 7 sets out substantially the same provision which was contained in the old statute.

With this explanation I am returning to you the certified copy of the ordinance annexing real property to the Village of Ormsby with the request that the certified copy be filed in your office.

Will you please acknowledge receipt of the enclosure. If, for any reason, you believe that the ordinance should not be filed in your office in view of my explanation, would you please advise me.
