A PROCLAMATION FOR SERBIAN DAY

WHEREAS, one of the foundation stones of Minnesota's prosperity and growth is the drive and energy which comes from the blending of a great many diverse cultural traditions into a unity of purpose and faith in Minnesota's future; and

WHEREAS, the Americans of Serbian descent in Minnesota have made and continue to make substantial contributions to the growth and development of our state; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that the people of Minnesota recognize these important contributions which strengthen their state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 12, 1959 as

"SERBIAN DAY"

and call upon all Minnesotans to recognize and honor the role of our citizens of Serbian descent who have helped to give our Land of 10,000 Lakes its strong and dynamic character.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty nine and of the state, the one hundred second.
