

CERTIFICATE

The undersigned, being the Judges of election duly appointed by Resolution of the County Board of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, dated July 13, 1959 to conduct the election upon the proposed incorporation of the Village of Cross Lake, Crow Wing County, Minnesota, to be held on August 7, 1959:

DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that such election was held in the school house in Watertown Township, Crow Wing County, Minnesota, on August 7, 1959. That the undersigned acted and remained as Judges at the polls continuously from 1:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. of that date. Upon the closing of the polls at 7:00 P.M. we, as Judges, duly canvassed the votes cast at said election and found that there were a total of 86 votes cast, that of this total 49 votes were cast for said incorporation and 37 votes were cast against said incorporation, and that said proposal for incorporation having received the majority of the votes cast was carried.



We, the undersigned voters, who have resided for a period of at least two years prior to the date hereof within the territory described as Sections Nineteen (19) to Thirty-six (36) inclusive in Watertown Township, Crow Wing County, Minnesota, which territory is not now within the limits of any incorporated municipality, and part of which has been platted into lots and blocks in the manner provided by law, said territory containing a resident population of not less than 100 persons and includes unplatted lands adjoining the platted areas and all of which is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to Village government, do hereby respectfully petition your honorable board to call an election for the determination of the incorporation of all of said described territory as a Village pursuant to the provisions of Section 412.011, Minnesota Statutes under the name of the Village of Cross Lake.

Your petitioners state and show that a census of the resident population within such described territory and a census list of buildings therein used for residences has been duly and properly taken and that the names of such residents and the buildings therein used as residences and the number of persons living in each are truly and correctly set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof. That said census was accurately taken on June 29, 1959 and June 30, 1959. That the quantity of land embraced within the boundaries of said territory proposed to be incorporated is approximately 9267 acres.
