



and by virtue of the authority vested in me by Royal Decree,
have appointed Mrs. Ingeborg Cecelia Bryn' OSTBY

to be Vice-Consul at Duluth, Minnesota, with a district comprising St. Louis,
Carlson, Itasca, Lake and Cook counties.

I hereby request all authorities concerned to show her all due trust and confidence and likewise render her such assistance as she may need in the exercise of her official duties, and that they will grant her all rights and favours accorded to Vice-Consuls of other friendly Powers in the Country where she is stationed.
