KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, hereby appoint Lorraine Pions to act with Alice Trowbridge as Co-Administrators of the Code of Fair Competition for the hairdressing and beauty culture trade for the trade areas of Northeastern Minnesota, Twin Cities, Southern Minnesota, and trade area No. 4, as the said four trade areas are now constituted and established, and hereby authorize and fix payment of compensation to each of said persons for their services in the sum of Sixty Dollars (\$60) per month, plus reasonably related operating expenses, all to be paid out of the funds obtained by assessments from persons engaged in such industry in said trade areas and as provided for in such Code.

The Co-Administrators shall be assisted in their duties by the employees of the State Board of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture when so directed by the Co-Administrators.

All of said assessments shall be placed in one fund, and all of the foregoing disbursements shall be made therefrom, and all Executive Orders heretofore made inconsistent with this are hereby suspended.
