EXECUTIVE ORDER

1959 No. 5

WHEREAS, Minnesota Laws 1957, chapter 646, amending Minnesota Statutes 1953, section 645.07, provides that on such dates established by the Governor of the State of Minnesota, the standard of time in this state shall be one hour ahead of the mean solar time of the ninetieth meridian of longitude west of Greenwich, commonly known as Central Standard Time, so that time in use in this state will be in practicable conformance with time other than standard time in use elsewhere in the nation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby order that beginning at 2:00 a.m. on Sunday, June 21th and ending at midnight, July 1st, 1959, the time in use in this state shall be one hour ahead of such solar time.
