Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a Special Meeting of the Village Council was held on August 24, 1959 at 2:30 P.M.

Council Members present: Julius Anderson, Mayor, Eldon Milender and Leslie Olson, Trustees.

Absent: James Jaros and Richard Roberts.

The purpose of the meeting was to act upon a petition presented by Peter G. Pearson and his wife Hilda Pearson, and by J.H.F. Gould and his wife Lena Gould to have a parcel of land annexed to the Village of Warroad.

Having acted upon the petition the following Ordinance was adopted by the Council:

Ordinance No. 124

An Ordinance Relating to the Annexation of Certain Parcels of Land to the Village of Warroad

The Village Council of the Village of Warroad ordains:

Section 1: The purpose of this ordinance is to annex certain unplatted parcels of land to wit: East one eight 1/8 of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 32, Twp 163, Range 36, and the East one eight 1/8 of Lot Five, Sec. 32, Twp. 163-36 to the Village of Warroad.

Section 2: The signers of the petition, Peter G. Pearson and his wife Hilda Pearson, and J.H.F. Gould and his wife Lena Gould are the legal owners of the parcels of land described and affected by this ordinance.

Passed by the Village Council of the Village of Warroad this 24th day of August, 1959.
