ORDINANCE NO. 131

An Ordinance Annexing Lots One, Two, Three, and Four in Block 147 of Wildwood, to the Village of Mahtomedi.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MAHTOMEDI TO ORDNAM AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That pursuant to that certain petition signed by all of the owners of Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) in Block One Hundred Forty-seven (147) of Wildwood, in Washington County, Minnesota, containing less than two hundred acres, abutting on a Westerly side of the Village of Mahtomedi, requesting the annexation of said land to said Village, said Petition having been duly filed with the Clerk of said Village; and it appearing that such annexation will be to the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected, the Village boundaries of the Village of Mahtomedi are hereby extended to include said land described by the following boundary lines;

Commencing at the Northwesterly corner of Lot Four (4) in Block One Hundred Forty-seven (147) of Wildwood, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds for said Washington County, thence Southwesterly along the Northwesterly line of said Lot to the center line of Kenwood Street; thence Southeasterly along the center line of Kenwood Street to its intersection with the West line of the East Half of the Northeast Quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty (20), Township Thirty (30) North, Range Twenty-one (21), West (being a Westerly boundary line of the Village of Mahtomedi); thence North along the West line of said East Half of Northeast Quarter to the Southerly shore of Long Lake; thence Northwesterly along said shore of Long Lake to the point of beginning.

and that said territory is hereby made a part of the Village of Mahtomedi as effectually as if the same had originally been a part of said Village.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon the filing of a certified copy thereof with the County Auditor of Washington County and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota and with the Minnesota Municipal Commission and from and after its publication.
