A PROCLAMATION FOR "MOBILE HOME WEEK"

WHEREAS, more than 70,000 of our citizens live in mobile homes in this state; and

WHEREAS, these families spend nearly \$4 million each week in the ordinary staples of family living; and

WHEREAS, they are demonstrated to be good citizens, and an important part of our civic life, sending their children to our schools, taking active part in social, religious, civic and political affairs; and

WHEREAS, the mobile home industry is clearly an important economic segment of our life in Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of August 17th through August 24th, 1959 as

"MOBILE HOME WEEK"

and urge all citizens to mark it well.
