A PROCLAMATION FOR "YOUTH MONTH"

WHEREAS, September is Youth Month and, during the period from September 17th through September 30th, there will be an American Youth Enrollment to encourage children, especially pre-teenage boys and girls, to affiliate with one of our many youth-serving and character-building organizations; and

WHEREAS, parents and grand-parents will be urged to start constructive hobby activities for infants and other pre-teen children and to definitely pledge that these youngsters will be enrolled in character-building groups of church and community when they are of proper age;

HON, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September, 1959 as

"YOUTH MONTH"

and urge every citizen to participate in events being planned to help improve and perpetuate our American ideals, institutions and way of life, especially as they relate to our American youth.
