

A PROCLAMATION FOR "MINNESOTA DOG WEEK"

WHEREAS, the dog is a trusted and faithful member of many Minnesota households, and acts as both a protector and companion for its master; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of dog owners in Minnesota to train their dogs in obedience and to keep their dog from becoming a nuisance in the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, dog owners also seek to teach kindness and consideration by children and adults alike towards dogs.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 20 through September 26, 1959 as

"MINNESOTA DOG WEEK"
