A PROCLAMATION FOR "STUBEN DAY"

WHEREAS, General Friedrich Von Stuben, as Inspector general of the American Army under General George Washington, helped make possible our victorious struggle to establish an independent nation upon this continent; and

WHEREAS, September 17th is the anniversary of the birthdate of General Von Stuben; and

WHEREAS, the Stuben Society of America, which includes Minnesota citizens, plans to pay tribute to the memory of General Von Stuben on the occasion of his birthday.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 17, 1959 as

"STUBEN DAY"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens on this day to recognize the aid he rendered our country in its struggle for independence.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-sixth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine and of the state, the one hundred second.
