
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, MILLES LORD, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Sec. 8.06, Minn. Stat. 1953, and upon the request of the Commissioner of Highways, do hereby constitute and appoint JOHN G. ENGBERG of Excelsior, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General, and fix his compensation at the sum of \$7200.00 per annum, to be paid from and out of the Trunk Highway Fund. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the first day of August, 1959.

Dated at St. Paul, Minnesota, this third day of August, 1959.




