AN ORDINATICE MULATING TO THE ARTIGLATION OF CERTAIN FERITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF CHANNASSIN, MINNISCUL

The Village Council of the Village of Chenhadson, Minnebota, ordains:

SECTION 1. ANNEXATION. That the land hereinafter described in Section 2 hereof, the Village Council having determined that the annexation thereof is to the best interests of the village and to the territory affected, is hereby annexed to the included within the boudaries of the Village of Chanhassen pursuant to petition of the sole owner of said land and after considering the matter, pursuant to Subdivision 7, Section 3, Chapter 686, Laws of 1959.

SECTION 2. DESCRIPTION OF LAND ANNEXED. That the land hereby annoxed is situated in Carver County, Minnesota, and is described as follows, to-wit:
