An Ordinance Providing for the Acquisition of Property

Introduced by Councilman Harold H. Hokenstad

WHEREAS, a petition, signed by W. H. Nyberg, President and W. H. Nyberg, Secretary for Jobs Building Inc., dated August 21, 1959 has been filed with the City Council requesting the annexation of certain property to the City of Albert Lea, said petition containing the names of all owners of said property, and,

BEING, the City Council of the City of Albert Lea does determine that it will be to the best interests of the City of Albert Lea and said property to annex the same to the city, pursuant to Laws 1919, Chapter 66 Sec. 3, 1947, 71

The City of Albert Lea does ordain:

SEC. 1. The following described property, viz:

The east 155 ft. of lot 16, all of lots 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23 and that portion of Railroad Ave. lying adjacent to and easterly thereof, all in Jobs Building Sub. of part of the 1st, Sec. 21, T 202N, R. 61 W., County of Freeborn, State of Minnesota and recorded in Book 9 of plats, Page 4 in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Freeborn County, Minnesota

as included in the above mentioned petition, is hereby declared to be an addition to the City of Albert Lea as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.

SEC. 2. That lots 16-23 inclusive, Jobs Building sub. are hereby designated as M-2, Heavy Industrial District pending and shall so be indicated on the zoning district map.
