

ORDINANCE NO. 86 AS AMENDED (Original Ord.No.86

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOLEY, MINNESOTA, DO  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 86 of the Village of Foley  
is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That the Village boundaries of the Village of Foley  
are hereby extended so as to include the following described parcels  
of land abutting upon said village, to-wit:

(a.) The East 183 feet of the South 80 feet of the Northeast  
Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-  
five (35), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29),  
which is of record in the names of James L. Dziuk and Jacqueline  
M. Dziuk, husband and wife.

(b.) A strip of land 10 feet in width described as follows:  
Beginning at the Southwest corner of the tract described in paragraph  
"a"; thence north and parallel with the west line of the tract  
described in paragraph "a" to the south line of the Great Northern  
Railway right-of-way, being a distance of about 768 feet; thence  
southwesterly along said south line of said right-of-way about  
eleven and one-half (11 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet to a point on a north and south  
line drawn 10 feet west of said point of beginning; thence south  
and parallel with said west line of the tract described in  
paragraph "a" to a point 10 feet west of the point of beginning;  
thence east 10 feet to the point of beginning; which is of record  
in the name of William E. Kotsmith.

That the above described lands are unplatted and are less  
than 200 acres in area and that all of the owners of said lands  
have petitioned the Village Council for annexing said lands to  
the village.



ORDINANCE NO. 86

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOLEY, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Village boundaries of the Village of Foley are hereby extended so as to include the following described parcels of land abutting upon said village, to-wit:

(a.) The East 183 feet of the South 80 feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), which is of record in the names of James L. Dziuk and Jacqueline M. Dziuk, husband and wife.

(b.) A strip of land 10 feet in width described as follows:  
Beginning at the Southwest corner of the tract described in paragraph "a"; thence north and parallel with the west line of the tract described in paragraph "a" to the south line of the Great Northern Railway right-of-way, being a distance of about 768 feet; thence southwesterly along said south line of said right-of-way about eleven and one-half (11 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet to a point on a north and south line drawn 10 feet west of said point of beginning; thence south and parallel with said west line of the tract described in paragraph "a" to a point 10 feet west of the point of beginning; thence east 10 feet to the point of beginning; which is of record in the name of William E. Kotsmith.
