

ORDINANCE NO. 87

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOLEY, MINNESOTA, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Village boundaries of the Village of Foley
are hereby extended so as to include the following described parcel
of land abutting upon said village, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the middle of a public road
183 feet North of the center of Section Twenty-six (26),
Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29); thence
North along center of said public road 150 feet; thence
West and at right angles to said public road a distance
of 223.3 feet; thence South and parallel with said public
road a distance of 300 feet; thence East at right angles
to said public road a distance of 20 feet; thence North
and parallel with said public road a distance of 150 feet;
thence East and at right angles to said public road a
distance of 203.3 feet to the point of beginning; which is
of record in the names of Charles W. Towne and Rita M.
Towne, husband and wife.

Section 2. That the above described land is unplatted and
is less than 200 acres in area and that all of the owners of said
land have petitioned the Village Council for annexing said land
to the village.

RESOLUTION ANNEXING LAND OWNED BY VILLAGE
AND DEDICATING SAME AS A PUBLIC STREET

WHEREAS, the Village of Foley has recently become the owner
of the following described tract of land adjoining the village limits
and described as follows:

The East 223.3 feet of the South 33 feet of the
Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-seven (37),
Range Twenty-nine (29).

NOW, THEREFORE, be IT RESOLVED, that the Village Council of
the Village of Foley, Benton County, Minnesota, at its regular
meeting held on the sixth day of October, 1959, that the above
described tract of land is hereby incorporated into the village
limits and is hereby designated as a public street in said village
to be named at a later date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution
be recorded with the Register of Deeds of Benton County, Minnesota,
and that certified copies thereof be filed with the Secretary of
State, the State Commissioner of Highways, the State Municipal
Commission and the County Auditor of Benton County.
