WHEREAS, members of the National Federation of Grandmother Clubs of America have made outstanding contributions to life in their respective communities; and

WHEREAS, the Federation, with a membership of 20,000, has for the past twenty-one years observed the second Sunday in October as National Grandmothers' Day;

BEFORE, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, October 11, 1959, as

"GRANDMOTHERS' DAY"

in Minnesota and bring to the attention of the people of the state the contributions being made to our communities by grandmothers, and I urge all citizens, on that day, to join in tribute to these grand people who have obtained the happy state of grandmotherhood.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eleventh day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and of the state, the one hundred second.
