WHEREAS, the Holy Bible is its storehouse of truth can unfold to us many of the principles which we in this twentieth century are seeking to find; and


WHEREAS, the Loyalty National Committee is again sponsoring the Annual Observance of National Bible Week;




and urge all Minnesotans to partake again of the enlightening message for all people contained in the Holy Bible.
