

A PROCLAMATION FOR NATIONAL BIBLE WEEK

WHEREAS, we have succeeded to an unprecedented extent in conquering the elements of nature and unlocking their secrets, but have not yet obtained a secure knowledge and hold of the countless discoveries; and

WHEREAS, the Holy Bible in its storehouse of truth can unfold to us many of the principles which we in this twentieth century are seeking to find; and

WHEREAS, the Laymen's National Committee is again sponsoring its Annual Observance of National Bible Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 15 through October 25, 1959 as

NATIONAL BIBLE WEEK

and urge all Minnesotans to partake again of the enlightening message for all people contained in the Holy Bible.
